

SAWIS 1

1 PURPOSE

To determine the industry's vineyard status, as well as for general industry statistics and certification purposes. If returns are not rendered the grapes of the farm concerned may not be used for the production of certified wine of origin.

2 PARTIES THAT SHOULD COMPLETE THE FORM

Everybody that produce grapes on a farm for wine-making purposes (share-croppers excluded).

3 HOW TO COMPLETE THE FORM

3.1 New plantings

New plantings (excluding vines to fill the gaps) must be indicated at the bottom of the report.

3.2 Uprootings

- (i) Entire block - cross out the entire line;
- (ii) Portion of block - cross out the number of vines and indicate the balance above that.

3.3 Top graftings

- (i) Entire block - change in column "Variety" the grape variety to the new grape variety;
- (ii) Portion of block -cross out the number of vines and indicate the new grape variety and the number of vines grafted above that.

3.4 Correction of number of vines

Cross out the number of vines and indicate the correct number above that and mark it "correction/re-count".

4 GENERAL

Should the **producership** and/or the **boundaries of the farm** have changed during the year, please furnish particulars or contact one of the persons mentioned in paragraph 6.

If your **telephone and/or fax numbers**, as indicated in the upper right hand corner of the report, are omitted or incorrect, please complete or rectify.

5 SUBMISSION DATE

The form is send to all existing grape producers on an annual basis. The return(s) must reach SAWIS before or on 31 October. If there are no changes to vine statistics, indicate clearly on return "No changes" and return it to SAWIS immediately.
