

SAWIS 7 GUIDELINES

1 PURPOSE

The SAWIS 7 declares the quantity of packaged still, sparkling and fortified wine sold in the domestic market during a specific month. It is used to compile industry statistics.

2 PARTIES THAT SHOULD COMPLETE THE FORM

Should be completed by all wholesalers, producer cellars, estates and private cellars that sell still, sparkling and fortified wine in containers in the domestic market.

3 HOW TO COMPLETE THE FORM

3.1 The form consists of two sections:

- A container section (front page)
Divided into the different package types, and subdivided into package sizes.
- Price per litre category (overleaf)
Litres are filled in per wine type and per price category. The total sum of litres of still and sparkling wine is carried over to the container section on the form. Here the litres will be filled in per type of container, per package size as provided.

3.2 The Rand value per litre includes VAT and represents the price at which the product is sold directly to the consumer and members (cellar door sales), as well to the retail.

4 SUBMISSION DATE

With respect to producer cellars, estates and private cellars, the form, together with the SAWIS 5, 6 and 12 must be submitted to SAWIS on a monthly basis before the 15th of the following month.

This form must, with respect to wholesalers, be submitted to SAWIS on a monthly basis before the 15th of the following month.
