Binnelandse verkope van natuurlike wyn het vir die tydperk Mei 2010 tot April 2011 met **2.3% gestyg**. Dit is 'n voortsetting van die 2010 tendens van 2.7%.

Die uitvoer van natuurlike wyn in grootmaat het vir die tydperk Mei 2010 tot Junie 2011 met 13.9% gestyg. Daarteenoor het die uitvoer van verpakte natuurlike wyn oor dieselfde tydperk met 18.2% gedaal. Die styging in grootmaat wynuitvoere is in ooreenstemming met internasionale tendense.

Binnelandse verpakkingstendense vir die tydperk Januarie tot April 2011:

- **Glas toon 'n klein styging.**
- 47.3% van natuurlike wyn word in glashouers verpak, waarvan 53.3% in 750 ml grootte.
- 24.2% word in tapvate verpak, waarvan die 5 liter grootte die gewildste is.
- 24.7% word in plastiekhouders verpak met 43.9% en 38.8% in 1 liter en 5 liter onderskeidelik.
- Slegs 1.3% word in foeliesakke en 2.7% in tetrapak verpak.

Glas is die gewildste verpakking onder privaatkelders (86.2%) en groothandelaars (60.2%). Tapvate (37.6%) en plastiek (40.7%) is die gewildste onder produsentekelders, terwyl **tetrapak 'n styging van 2.8% vergeleke met die vorige ooreenstemmende tydperk toon.**

'n Onlangse persverklaring deur die OIV toon dat die wêreld se wingerdoppervlakte met 0.8% gedurende 2010 gedaal het en wynproduksie tot die vlak van 1998 gedaal het (263.8m hektoliter). Die goeie nuus is dat wynverbruik met 0.4% tot 238m hektoliter gestyg het. Die VSA, Duitsland en China is hoofsaaklik hiervoor verantwoordelik. 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Wine Industry Information

June 2011

Domestic natural wine sales increased by 2.3% for the period May 2010 to April 2011. This is a continuation of the 2010 trend of 2.7%.

Exports of natural wine in bulk increased with 13.6% for the period June 2010 to May 2011. However, the exports of packaged natural wine decreased with 18.2% over the same period. The increase of bulk wine exports is in line with international trends.

Domestic packaged information for the period January to April 2011:

- Glass shows a slight increase.
- 47.3% of natural wine is packed in glass containers of which 53.3% in 750 ml size containers.
- 24.2% is packed in bag-in-box, most popular being the 5 litre container.
- 24.7% is packed in plastic containers with 43.9% and 38.8% in 1 litre and 5 litre respectively.
- Only 1.3% is packed in foil bags and 2.7% in tetrapak.

Glass is the most popular container amongst private cellars (86.2%) and wholesalers (60.2%). Bag-in-box (37.6%) and plastic (40.7%) are popular containers amongst producer cellars, while tetrapak shows an increase of 2.8% compared to the previous corresponding period.

In a recent press release the OIV stated that the global vineyard surface decreased with 0.8% during 2010 and wine production fell to 1998 levels (263.8m hectolitres). The good news is that wine consumption increased with 0.4% to 238m hectolitres. USA, Germany and China are fuelling this slight increase. [Click here](#) to read the full press release.
