Wine Industry Information

July 2012

Domestic natural wine sales increased by 3.8% for the period June 2011 to May 2012. Exports of natural wine in bulk increased with 19.9% and exports of packaged natural wine decreased with 10.2% for the period July 2011 to June 2012; overall an increase of 3.8%.

Domestic packaged information for the period January to May 2012:

- Glass shows an increase of 5.9%.
- 49.7% of natural wine is packaged in glass containers of which 55.4% in 750 ml size containers.
- 26.2% is packaged in bag-in-box, most popular being the 5 litre container.
- 21.9% is packaged in plastic containers with 41.0% and 48.3% in 1 litre and 5 litre respectively.
- Only 0.3% is packaged in foil bags and 2% in tetrapak.
- There are no significant changes in these trends.
